

Key Lime Poke Cake

This cake is a favourite here at The Lending Cupboard. If you like a hint of zest in your dessert, we highly recommend you try this recipe!

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup key lime, bottled juice
- 1 lime
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 box white cake mix
- 1 (14 oz) can of sweetened condensed milk
- 2 1/4 cups whipping cream

Preparation:

Prepare and bake the cake according to package instructions in a 9x13-inch baking pan. Let cool for 5 minutes, then poke holes all over the cake with the handle of a wooden spoon. Don't don't poke through to the bottom. Set aside. For the filling, add sweetened condensed milk, whipping cream and lime zest to a medium bowl. Whisk to combine. Add lime juice and, once again, whisk to combine. It will start to thicken quickly; pour over the cake, spreading with a spatula to encourage it to fill in holes. Chill for at least 1 hour and up to overnight.

While the cake chills, make the topping. In a medium bowl, add whipping cream and vanilla extract. Beat with an electric mixer until it begins to thicken, then gradually add powdered sugar and continue beating until stiff peaks form.

Spread over cake and garnish with sliced limes and lime zest, if desired. Enjoy!
