

Indulge Your Taste Buds Double Butterscotch Coconut Cake Recipe

Total Time

Prep: 20 min. Bake: 40 min. + cooling

<u>Makes</u>

16 servings

Ingredients

- 1 package yellow cake mix (regular size)
- 1 package (3.4 ounces) instant butterscotch pudding mix
- 4 large eggs
- 1 cup canned coconut milk
- 1/4 cup canola oil
- 1 cup sweetened shredded coconut
- 1/2 cup butterscotch chips

Glaze

1/2 cup butterscotch chips

2 tablespoons heavy whipping cream

1/3 cup sweetened shredded coconut, toasted

Directions

1)Preheat oven to 350°. Grease and flour a 10-in. fluted tube pan.

2)In a large bowl, combine cake mix, pudding mix, eggs, coconut milk and oil; beat on low speed 30 seconds. Beat on medium speed 2 minutes. Stir in coconut and butterscotch chips. Transfer batter to prepared pan.

3)Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, 40-45 minutes. Cool in pan 10 minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely.

For glaze, in a microwave, melt butterscotch chips and cream; stir until smooth. Drizzle over cake; sprinkle with coconut.
